

# Drop Off / Pick Up Process



Face to Face Scouting at the Den



- No one who is unwell or has flu like symptoms can enter the Mount Cotton Scout Group site.
- Parents are not permitted to enter the buildings or under-covered area.
- Each section will have a designated registration (drop off) and pick up procedure.
- All members onsite will apply hand sanitiser before entering the buildings / under-covered area.
- Pre, During & Post Cleaning will be carried out each night.
- The kitchens remain closed.
- Youth members need to bring their own filled water bottle, and for Scouts and older, their own pen.
- The walking track from the top car park will be for down hill traffic only.
- Up hill traffic will walk up the driveway.
- Note: there are separate requirements for outdoor only scouting activities.


